



Daniel Sperling

Professor, University of California, Davis

Dr. Daniel Sperling is Distinguished Professor of Civil Engineering and Environmental Science and Policy, and founding Director of the Institute of Transportation Studies at the University of California, Davis (ITS-Davis). He has served for 11 years seat on the California Air Resources Board, appointed to the transportation seat by Governors Arnold Schwarzenegger and Jerry Brown, and served as Chair of the Transportation Research Board of the National Academies in 2015-16. Among his many prizes are the 2013 Blue Planet Prize from the Asahi Glass Foundation Prize for being “a pioneer in opening up new fields of study to create more efficient, low-carbon, and environmentally beneficial transportation systems.” He served twice as lead author for the IPCC (sharing the 2007 Nobel Peace Prize), has testified 7 times to the US Congress. He has authored or co-authored over 300 technical papers and 12 books, including *Three Revolutions: Steering Automated, Shared, and Electric Vehicles to a Better Future*. He earned a PhD in Transportation Engineering from UC Berkeley and a BS in Environmental Engineering from Cornell University.
