Mayumi Matsumoto is a visiting associate professor at the University of Tokyo, the Environment and Energy Department, the Faculty of Arts and Sciences. She teaches courses on world renewable energy policies and science literacy at the university.

She graduated from Sophia University with major in comparative culture, foreign language faculty in 1988. She worked as a news anchor at TV Asahi and NHK BS1 from 1987 to 1998. She joined nonprofit organization activities on environmental and energy issues in 2003. She has started research activities as a researcher at Research Center for Advanced Science and Technology, the University of Tokyo since 2008, and has been a visiting associate professor since 2014. She has also been a director of International Environmental Economic Institute (IEEI) and a director of Japan Council of Renewable Energy (JCRE). Her specialty is energy policy study and science communication, which is the study of public communication of science-related topics and the methods of enhancing science literacy.
